Dear Prime Minister,

Mr Abousfian Abdelrazik is now home in Canada, in keeping with his rights as a Canadian citizen. But he has not had these rights fully restored. He can, for instance, be refused the opportunity to open a bank account or to obtain employment because he remains on the UN no-fly list. This, in spite of the fact that the RCMP and the Canadian Security Intelligence Service have cleared him of any terrorist connections. Mr. Justice Russel Zinn has blasted this UN no-fly or blacklist as Kafkaesque, noting that it is impossible for someone like Mr. Abdelrazik to challenge the vague assertions involved of links to al-Qaeda.

Justice requires your government to take every step open to it to remove these impediments to Mr. Abdelrazik's everyday life. The reputation of Canada as a free and just society is imperiled. Canadian Unitarians for Social Justice implore you to do so.
