

The First Unitarian Fellowship of Nanaimo passed this resolution at a congregational meeting on Sunday:

Citing our 5th Principle “the right of conscience and the use of the democratic process within our congregations and in society at large” and citing our 7th Principle “respect for the interdependent web of all existence of which we are a part”, the First Unitarian Fellowship of Nanaimo opposes the construction of the proposed Enbridge Northern Gateway Pipeline, and the passage of oil tankers through the Douglas Channel.

It was overwhelming but not quite unanimous.
